Grants of £2000 to £5000

Round 1 is open, and closes 22nd September for a panel early October

Supporting Community and voluntary groups across Stafford

Grants up to £500

Round open, and will close for applications on 13th October

Eligibility and process



Eligibility

- Individual criteria for each fund
- Constituted groups, registered charities, social enterprises (such as CIC's)
- Aim to benefit the community
- Be able to provide supporting documents

Process

- Compliance Checked
- Assessed
- Panel discussion
- Decision made

- Latest set of Accounts
- Quotes for capital costs
- Policies – including safeguarding and equality
