

CHARGES

You will be asked to make a payment towards the cost of the driver's expenses. This is based on mileage.

5 – 5.9 miles	£4.50
7 – 7.9 miles	£5.30
10 – 10.9 miles	£6.20
12 – 12.9 miles	£6.80
15 – 15.9 miles	£8.70

25 – 29.9 miles	£15.60
30 – 34.9 miles	£17.80
35 – 40 miles	£19.60
